

PRIVACY NOTICE

This Privacy Notice sets out Jonas and Christina af Jochnick Foundation's policies with the collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information on anyone who decides to use our website and e-mail.

If you choose to use our website and e-mail, then you agree to the collection and use of information in relation with this policy. The Personal Information that we collect are used for providing and improving the use of our website. Information Collection and Use

What Are Cookies
